CERTIFICATE CRITERIA FOR IOQM 2024

From this year upto two certificates will be awarded to each student: the National Certificate and a Regional certificate from the region the student participates. Rules for determining the cutoff for the same are stated below:

NATIONAL CERTIFICATE

- (1) Let N be the number of candidates who wrote the IOQM exam.
- (2) The cutoff C is the smallest possible integer such that the number of students who score $\geq C$ marks is $\leq (10\% \text{ of } N)$.
- (3) The National Certificate is awarded to all students with score $\geq C$.

REGIONAL CERTIFICATE

- (1) Relevant cutoff for the Regional Certificate is dependent on the region from which the student participated. List of regions can be found at the link https://www.mtai.org.in/rmo-region-codes/.
- (2) Let $N_{\mathbf{R}}$ be the number of candidates who wrote the IOQM exam from the region \mathbf{R} .
- (3) The regional cutoff $C_{\mathbf{R}}$ is the smallest possible integer such that the number of students who score $\geq C_{\mathbf{R}}$ marks from the region \mathbf{R} is $\leq (10\% \text{ of } N_{\mathbf{R}})$.
- (4) A Regional Certificate is awarded to all students who participated from region \mathbf{R} and have a score $\geq C_{\mathbf{R}}$.

Remark. Since the regional cutoff may be both less than or more than the national cutoff, a student may get the National Certificate or the Regional Certificate or both or none.
